

THE CAPTAIN'S PRIZE- CAPTAINS WEEKEND 28th 29th August 2010.

Captains Weekend Format

THE CAPTAINS BOARD PRIZE WILL BE THE BEST 36 NET AGGREGATED TOTAL SCORE RETURNED DURING THE WEEKEND SUBJECT TO A HANDICAP LIMIT OF 18.

DAY 1 SATURDAY FINAL QUALIFYING -PREQUALIFIERS PLAY 18 HOLES SINGLES STROKE PLAY TO QUALIFY FOR SUNDAY CAPTAINS DAY CARRYING THEIR SCORE FORWARD TO DAY 2.

DAY 2 SUNDAY CAPTAINS DAY-FINAL QUALIFIERS FROM SATURDAY PLAY 18 HOLES SINGLES STROKE PLAY FOR THE CAPTAINS PRIZE BASED ON THEIR WEEK END AGGREGATED 36 HOLE TOTAL SCORES RETURNED (DAY 1 PLUS DAY 2 SCORES)

DAY 2 SUNDAY INCLUDES A 18 HOLE NON QUALIFIERS SINGLES STROKE PLAY EVENT IN THE MORNING.

Pre Qualifying

There will be 6 pre qualifying rounds for the final qualifying Saturday day of Captains weekend with the 21 best net and 4 best gross qualifying in each round (regardless of division). The best 4 gross qualifying scores must break 80.

Should there not be 4 gross qualifiers, the best net scores will increase accordingly.

Final Qualifying Saturday 28th Aug 2010-Day 1

From a field of 150 pre qualifiers plus Captains guests the best 60 net scores and tied will qualify for Captains Day Sunday.

The Captain will invite 4 guests to play including last years Captains Prize winner. Last years captains prize winner is exempt from pre qualifying and may compete for the Captains prize table through the Captains weekend. Maximum field entry will be 154.

Captains Day Sunday 29th Aug 2010-Day 2

Final 60 qualifiers will compete on this day for the 2010 Captains Prizes.

Non Qualifiers Sunday Morning 29th August 2010-Day 2

There will be a 18 hole non qualifiers event that will run in the morning of captains day. **Final qualifiers from Saturday who do not qualify for Sunday will be unable to enter this event.**

Handicap Limit & CONGU

A limit of 18 handicap will be applied to final Saturday qualifying Day 1 and Captains Day Sunday Day 2. This applies to all the Captains donated prizes. All divisional (club) prizes will be awarded in the normal manner through Captains weekend to a max 28 handicap for the 4th division.

All qualifiers before final qualifying on the Saturday must have 3 club qualifying rounds returned during 2010-No return cards do not count. All competitors must have active CONGU handicaps to play in any captains event.

No changes to handicaps apply through the Captains weekend. CONGU 2008-11 Decision 4 (a) page 86 rule applies.

Start Sheets

Pre Qualifying- Start sheets will be posted in the normal manner as per club diary and web page. **See agreed fixtures dates web page and diary.**

Final Qualifying Day 1- The start sheet match times will be allocated in handicap order (lowest handicaps last out) and posted to the notice board 17th August 2010. Start times 7.30 until 3.15 pm at 8 minute intervals 3 ball format. **There will be no facility to change allotted times.** If any members are unable to play they must advise the committee and a replacement will be found before 17th August 2010. After each pre qualifying event qualifier lists will be posted to the notice board. **Members should check these lists and advise committee accordingly if they cannot play in Captains weekend.** If a member plays in the final Saturday qualifying round and qualifies for Sunday (Captains Day) each qualifier will be expected to play at the allotted time on the Sunday-see allotted times note below.

Captains Day -Day 2 The start sheet match times will be allocated based on best net score returned (lowest net scores returned from Day 1 last out in Day 2). Day 2 times will be posted to the clubs web page at 9pm following competition close for Saturday Day 1. A start sheet will available on the notice board locker room, in the pro's shop and behind the bar for phone confirmations of allocated start times as soon as finalised.

There will be no facility to change allotted start times. It is the competitors responsibility to ensure that they are aware of their start match time. Normal club rules will apply-see no shows note. Start times 12.00 until 3.30 pm at 10 minute intervals 3 ball format.

Non Qualifiers Captains Day morning-Day 2. The start sheet for this event will be posted 2 weeks before Captains weekend in the normal manner. Start time 7.30 am to 11.30 am 78 competitors at 8 minute intervals 3 ball format.

Allotted Times

No shows for allotted times-This will be subject to normal club competition rules, however, the Captain and or the Handicaps and Competitions Chairman have the authority to consider exceptional circumstances in context of this situation. **Change requests for allotted time-**The Captain and or the Handicaps and Competitions Chairman have the authority to consider exceptional circumstances in context of this situation. Exceptional circumstance's for change requests will not normally include other sporting events.

Prizes

Pre Qualifying- 1 to 4 Divisional Prizes for each of the 6 events

Final Saturday Qualifying Day- 1 to 4 Divisional plus 1 Gross Prizes for this 18 hole event.

Captains Day Sunday Day 2- The Captains Prize 36 holes best net (the captains board prize), The Captains Gross Prize 36 holes, The Captains Veterans Prize 36 holes applies to over 55s at Final Qualifying Date. Handicap limit of 18 applies -see handicap limit above. Club prizes 1- 4 Divisional plus 1 Gross Prize (Handicap max of 28 applies for divisions).

Non Qualifiers Sunday Day 2- 1st Prize and 2nd Prize (Handicap max of 28 applies)

Priority of prize allocation based on scores returned day 1 and day 2. Priority order is agreed as the Captains 36 best net score (the captains board prize) and then the Captains 36 hole best gross followed by other 36 hole prizes from the captains weekend qualifiers then club prizes for Sunday day 2 best 18 hole returns (divisions then gross) and then club prizes for day 1 Saturday best 18 hole returns (divisions then gross). **No individual may receive more than one prize from the Final Saturday Qualifying Day 1 and Captains Day Sunday Day 2.**

Entry Fees

The normal club entry fee will apply to all events relating to Captains 2010 prize plus 2s sweep.

Evening Dinner Presentation

All competitors and male members invited to the evening dinner followed by a mixed social.

All prizes will be presented after the evening dinner on Captains Day Sunday 29th August 2010.

The winner of the Captain's Prize plus other prizes must attend the presentation to accept prize's.

Decisions & Rules

Committee decisions will be final in conjunction with Captains approval.

Committee reserve the right to change dates, formats, start times, prizes and rules due to exceptional circumstances including adverse weather conditions.
